

Waste Heat Recovery Potential Locations

Rockies Express Pipeline LLC is participating in a voluntary program to facilitate the development of compressor heat recovery for power generation, as detailed in a recently released INGAA white paper entitled “Waste Heat Recovery Opportunities: Pipelines Present Energy Efficient Proposal”. The white paper suggests that pipelines post a listing of gas turbine compressor stations on their system that:

1. Have a total gas turbine station capacity of at least 15,000 hp; and,
2. Operated at or more than 5,200 hours (60% load factor) over the last 12 months.

Rockies Express currently has nine gas turbine compressor stations that meet the criteria stated above located in the following counties/states: Sweetwater County, Wyoming (Wamsutter), Gage County, Nebraska (Steele City), Audrain County, Missouri (Mexico), Putnam County, Indiana (Bainbridge), Rio Blanco County, Colorado (Meeker), Muskingum County, Ohio (Chandlersville), Pickaway County, Ohio (Columbus), Fayette County, Ohio (Washington Court House) and Decatur County, Illinois (St. Paul).

Rockies Express is willing to consider proposals from legitimate 3rd party developers for Recovered Energy Generation (REG) waste heat recovery at these compressor stations.
