

REX FORCE MAJEURE – SEGMENT 260

On Wednesday, August 2, 2017, Rockies Express Pipeline LLC (“REX”) experienced an operational issue downstream of the Steele City Compressor Station in Gage County, Nebraska which will require a flow reduction to 0 through the segment. REX is currently mobilizing crews to investigate and complete any necessary repairs.

Accordingly, REX is declaring a Force Majeure situation pursuant to Section 21 of its tariff, which requires a capacity reduction through Segment 260 until the repairs are completed.

Effective for the ID 3 Cycle, Gas Day Wednesday, August 2, 2017, REX will schedule quantities through Segment 260 to the Elapsed Prorated Scheduled Quantities (“EPSQ”).

Effective for the Evening Cycle, Gas Day Thursday, August 3, 2017, REX will schedule quantities through Segment 260 to 0 MDth/d. However, a return to service date is anticipated to occur in time to accept nominations for the ID 1 Cycle, Gas Day Thursday, August 3, 2017.
